When I first met Christ It seemed as though life was rather like a bike ride, But it was a tandem bike, And I noticed that Christ Was in the back helping me pedal.

I don't know just when it was that He suggested we change places, But life has not been the same since.

When I had control, I knew the way, It was rather boring, but predictable...

It was the shortest distance between two points.

But when He took the lead, He knew delightful long cuts, Up mountains, and through rocky places, At breakneck speeds, It was all I could do to hang on! Even though it looked like madness, He said, "Pedal"

I worried and was anxious and asked, "Where are you taking me?" He laughed and didn't answer, And I started to learn to trust.

I forgot my boring life
And entered into the
adventure. And when I'd say,
"I'm scared,"He'd lean back and
touch my hand.

He took me to people with gifts that I needed. Gifts of healing, acceptance, and joy. He said, "Give the gifts away; They're extra baggage, too much weight."

So I did, I gave them to the people we met, And I found that in giving I received, And still our burden was light.



I did not trust Him, at first, In control of my life.
I thought He'd wreck it;
But He knows bike secrets,

Even now. before you have any idea of who that pastor may be, please pray for them, that God prepare them and open them to the possibility of a new venture. One last prayer request – please pray for yourself and the congregation, that you all would be open to that new pastor and the new ideas and ministry s/he might bring.
